Course overview

Two suitable references may be required and you should ideally be working at a Level 2 in English and maths.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is designed to prepare you for the full range of assessment methods you will experience at university including presentations, written assignments, posters and online elements.

What can I do next?

This qualification will provide you with a range of transferable skills so that you can progress onto a range of our HE courses.

Will I have to pay fees?

Tuition fees are free if you are a UK or home- fee status student and aged 16-18 on the 31st August before the start of your course.

If you are aged 19 or over, you may be required to pay fees depending on your residency status, educational background and personal circumstances.

Level 3 Entitlement: If you are aged 19 - 23 on the start date of the course and this is your first full Level 3 qualification the course is free. For more information please contact Course Information on 01642 333333.

Advanced Learner Loan: If you are aged 19-23 and this is not your first full Level 3 qualification or you are aged 24 or over on the start date of the course, you will have to pay fees. However, you may qualify for an Advanced Learner Loan. You can apply for an Advanced Learning Loan from Student Finance England (SFE) to fund all or part of the fee. The Advanced Learner Loan will not be repayable by students who progress into Higher Education and complete their degree.
