Exam one:

For this exam you will explore how love has been presented in literature throughout history. You will study:

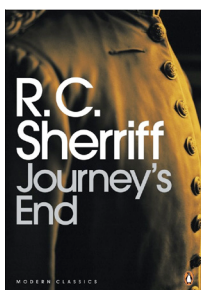
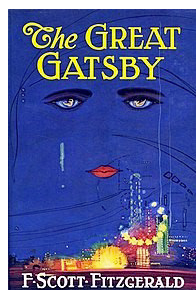
- One Shakespeare play (Othello)

Exam two:

Texts in Shared Contexts

For this exam you will study a range of literature both from and about The First World War. This will include:

- R.C. Sherriff's Journey's End
- An anthology of WW1 poems
- Pat Barker's Life Class



On this course you will:

- Read a range novels, plays and poetry from a variety of genres and literary movements
- Gain an understanding of the historical contexts of the texts studied as well as an overview of different literary movements throughout history
- Develop your skills of analysis and understanding of the technical terminology used in the study of literature
