# Fashion Communication



**A** \$AP Rocky is an American rapper born and raised in Harlem, New York City. He is renowned for his experimental approach to music, his flair for fashion, his penchant for psychedelic drugs and his prolific love life. In terms of family life, at the age of 12 Rocky's father was jailed for drug dealing and older brother was sadly murdered at the age of 29 by a rival dealer. Since then, he has increasingly revealed an artistic, eccentric, dandified side of his character as he has gravitated away from Harlem towards downtown Manhattan. Since the start of his career, he has now collaborated with the designers Raf Simons and Jonathan Anderson, and in 2016, became the face of Dior Homme and the first person of colour to represent the luxury menswear brand.



In August 2011, Rocky's single "Peso" was leaked online and within weeks began receiving radio airplay. He then released his debut mixtape *Live. Love. \$\$.AP.* later that year to widespread critical acclaim. The success of what is considered his breakout project led to a joint venture record deal with Polo Grounds Music and Sony Music's RCA Records.

## THE FALL

Vivienne has worked with some of the world's most famous prestigious models in the world, from Naomi Campbell in the 90's to Bella Hadid in more recent times. She's proven that her designs can evolve with time whilst also staying authentic to her brand.

Naomi and Vivienne worked closely together, specifically in the 90's creating a new waisted and wonderful haute couture style that graced the runway.

At that time Vivienne didn't pay her models very much to walk for her therefore Naomi was proof that she believed in Vivienne's views and her fashion. Having models like her helped the fashion industry get behind her human rights and climate change. Naomi famously fell during one of Vivienne's shows which created a huge amount of publicity towards the brand. During a Vogue interview Naomi admitted to designers backstage asking if she would purposely fall however she declined as it was against her ethics. For most designers they would see one of their models falling disastrous but Vivienne saw beauty in it as her brand was all about being perfectly imperfect.



Charles Leclerc is a Ferrari driver who is thought to be Ferrari's next golden boy and the driver they have put the most faith in. He was given the longest contract in F1 history in 2019 for five years. There he has got over 23 poles and multiple wins and podiums. He is one of the most marketable drivers on the grid and is one of a lot of drivers who want to work with Mercedes. He has over 12 million Instagram followers. He often does work with the Ferrari clothing brand and lots of PR work on social media with sponsorship and the team which has helped build his profile to what it is.

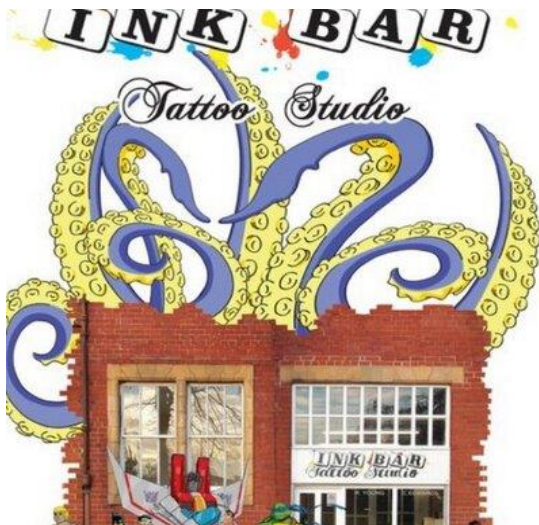
